SORÌ PAITIN VECCHIE VIGNE Barbaresco Riserva 2015

97 pts

A fantastic Barbaresco with aromas and flavors of white truffles, bark, dust, walnuts and tile, as well as plums and dried strawberries. It's full bodied with plenty of tannins, yet there's a really impressive, linear feel running through it that provides tension and form. Try after 2024.



SORÌ PAITIN Serraboella Barbaresco 2017

94 pts

Another Barbaresco from this winery that shows such a solid core of fruit and tannins with plenty of plum, strawberry, cedar and walnut character. Some porcini mushrooms, too. It's full-bodied tannic and powerful at the finish. Try after 2024.



SERRABOELLA Barbaresco 2017

95 pts

A vivid, solid Barbaresco with intense density of fruit and ripe tannins. It's full-bodied with lots of plums and chocolate with some walnuts and bark. Extremely flavorful and powerful. Try after 2024.



CA VEJA Nebbiolo d'Alba 2017

90 pts

Dried strawberries, pencil shavings and dried mushrooms on the nose. Medium bodied with juicy fruit and a flavorful finish. Slightly smoky, tarry aftertaste.



STARDA Langhe Nebbiolo 2018

92 pts

Really pretty on the nose with ripe berries, cherries and strawberries that follow through to a medium body with round, soft tannins and a juicy finish.
